

BOARD OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES
MINUTES OF MARCH 15, 2010 MEETING

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 6:34 by the Chair.

PRESENT: Pam Gill, Teresa Lyons, Mary Ellen Picardi, Beth Spellman, Joanne Vannah, Mary O'Connell and Ewa Jankowska.

CHAIRMAN'S RPT. The Chair wants to gather as much pertinent information as possible to present an accurate program for Information Night on March 29th. Suggestions are discussed as to what information should be displayed on a power point presentation. The Trustees would like to gather comparable information on the surrounding communities budgets for their Libraries

Pam states that she will be attending the next Finance committee meeting.

The MLTA has mailed invitations directly to Trustees homes for an upcoming symposium on Violence in Libraries to be held on April 10th at the MBLC. Mary Ellen Picardi and Pam Gill are interested in attending. There is no charge for this seminar. Contained in this seminar will be new safety and security issues confronting library employees and patrons which are of great interest to our library.

Ewa states that she and Mary attended Legislative Day at the State House in Boston.

Ewa would like to send invitations to the upcoming Information Night to our State Representatives.

Pam asked Joanne Vannah to discuss the results of her recent meeting with the School Department Business Manager, relative to the 3 million dollar green school grant that may be available to the schools if the Library becomes recertified.

She defines MGL Chapter 312, authority to spend capital outlay funds. She also discussed the possibility of pairing with the Alternative Energy Committee to make a proposal for energy revenues to go to the School Department in perpetuity with a partial investment of the 3 million dollar grant.
