May highlights include a Pastels Class and a performance of "Meet Julia Child" by the Delvena Theater Company. Summer Reading theme this year is Oceans of Possibilities with a focus on Sharks in collaboration with the Atlantic White Shark Conservancy. There will also be a program for Teens and Adults. The Confidential Corner program suggested by Trustee Murray to be implemented by mid-May. The library will be hosting eight summer concerts in partnership with the Iron Works (NPS) on Wednesday evenings beginning July 12 and ending August 30.
