- 4. Library Director's Report presented by Director Thibeault (see attached): Holiday Calendar revised for 2023-2024. Library will be closed Monday June 19th in observance of Juneteenth. Andrea Bunker, library building specialist from the Massachusetts Board of Library Commissioners visited the library to discuss space utilization and make some general observations at the library. This is the first step in the space utilization study over the next two years. Three candidates have been interviewed for the 12 hour a week library associate. Expects to announce the selection soon and intend to announce the 18 hour a week candidate as well. The summer reading program begins next week on June 20th. The "Confidential Corner" is now in place and available for patrons. It is in a discreet location on the second floor. Information is available on the library website.
