STREET CULTURE & the STREET ORGAN**

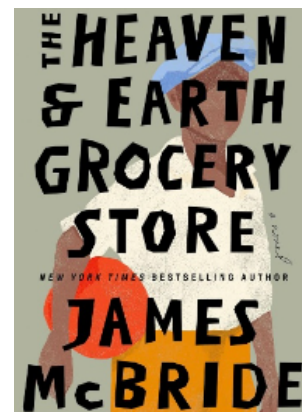

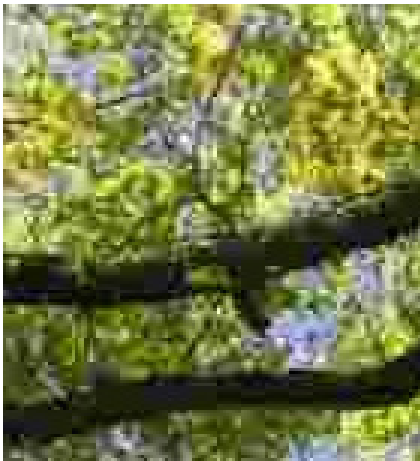

➤➤➤ **Lovers of Trees and Saugus History**

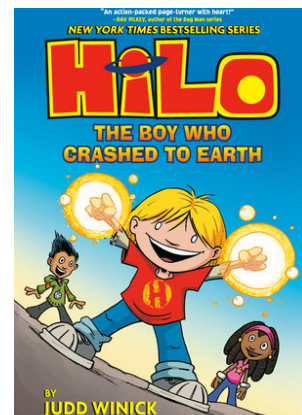
Monday, May 16, 6-30 pm
